This will provide another voice in preaching and teaching, as diversity in preaching helps congregation members grow in faith. It will also expand our capacity to care for those in need in our congregation.

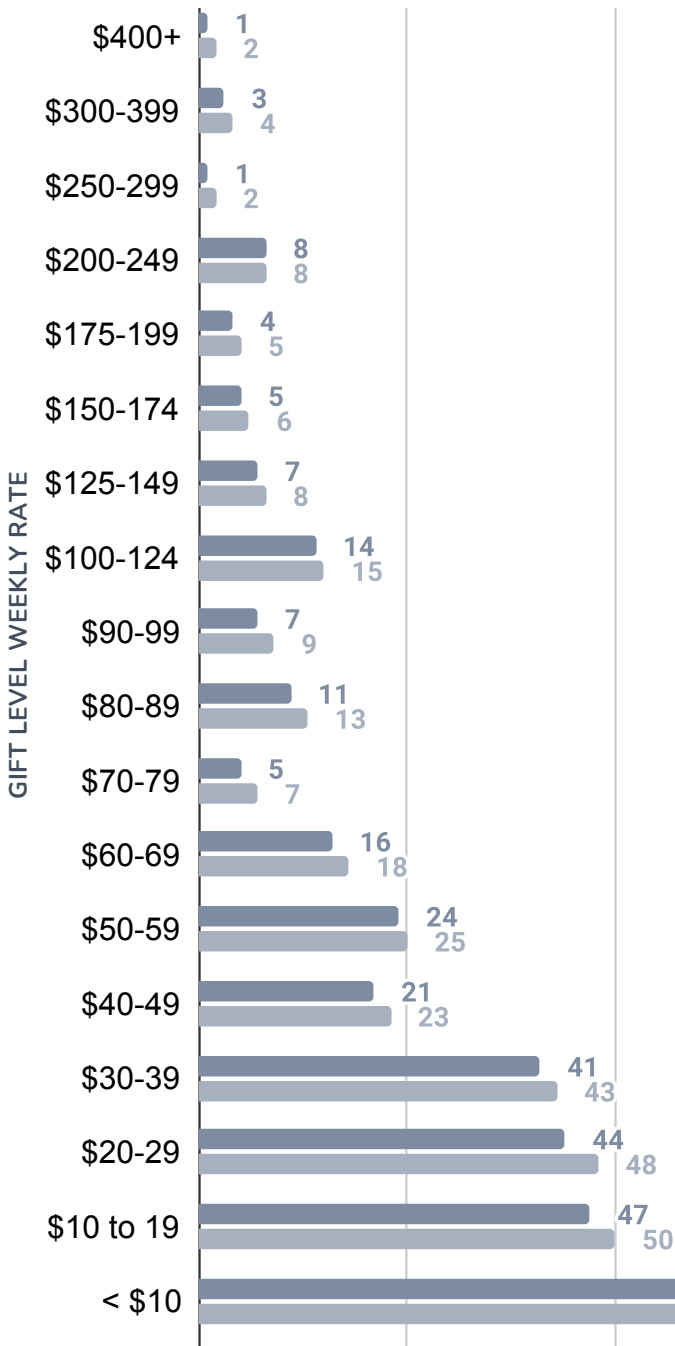
